



## Loving Garland Green Interactions and Collaborations

Regardless the group we are interacting/collaborating with, the purpose of our coming together ultimately results in the support or creation of another urban garden in Garland. An urban garden of edibles is at the heart of any project we undertake.

### **With Individuals**

Members of Loving Garland Green interact and collaborate with residents of Garland as individuals. Examples of this include our program: **Another Urban Garden**. Members of Loving Garland Green work with individuals to help them install square foot gardens in their homes.

### **With Neighborhoods**

Members of Loving Garland Green interact and collaborate with whole neighborhoods—first at our own individual level in our own neighborhood and secondly with other neighborhoods in our community. We support the creation of small neighborhood gardens. Currently we are working with The Good Samaritans to assist them in establishing a neighborhood garden at their 12<sup>th</sup> Street address.

### **With Organizations**

Members of Loving Garland Green interact and collaborate with various nonprofit organizations including local Garland City departments and commissions in furthering our mission to increase the number of people in our community who grow some of the food they eat.

### **With Residents of Garland at Large**

Members of Loving Garland Green interact and collaborate with the community at a municipal level in numerous ways. For example, membership in our organization is open to any resident of Garland as well as anyone who lives in the DFW area. We participate in municipal events such as the Garland Marketplace, the upcoming Health Fair, the 2014 Neighborhood Summit, and we are the stewards for the first community garden located on city property at 4022 Naaman School Road.
