#2 Cost for recommended soil amendments

Note: both #1 and #2 are one-time expenses.

- 1) Compost (\$10.00 from Loving Garland Green)
- 2) Vermiculite or expanded shale (\$20.00)
- 3) Sphagnum moss \$10.00
- 4) Garden soil \$20.00

#3 Cost for plants

Note: Cost for plants will vary according to plant selection and whether purchasing transplants or planting from seed.

Range can be from \$11.00 to \$30.00 for a 4 by 8 foot bed.

A raised bed installed by members of Loving Garland Green will cost you close to \$100.00.

A raised bed installed by a landscaper will cost you about \$500.00.

The difference being: Loving Garland Green does not charge for labor and because we will haul the compost to you, you get about \$60 of compost for \$10.

Note: We are no longer gathering 70% off lumber for residents as we've found that puts an uncontrolled variable into the process. (We are not in control of the availability of this lumber and thus cannot schedule installation of these beds in a timely manner. Often week may go by before we can secure enough of this lumber to construct even one bed.)
