
Note to Reviewers: Some of the number for the street addresses may need correction. Sources vary and it's often difficult to tell how many lots one property occupies.

1. Corner First and Austin (321 on First – Corner First and Austin)



A grouping of three blackberry bushes at this corner with a small sign about three feet high announcing entrance to Walkable Main Village might look good here. Behind house on corner as you walk down Austin



2. 112 Austin VACANT LOT with chain link fence. Behind the house on the corner of Austin and First there is a large vacant area that is fenced in with a chain link fence.





3. 4. 5. Following the chain link fence, there is a series of three commercial buildings. The middle building is Electronic Systems Support



This is the third one of the three commercial buildings on Austin (walking west).



6. VACANT LOT there is a lovely vacant lot next to the series of three commercial buildings.







8. 9. 210 and 208 Austin—two residences.

These appear to currently be the only two residences located on Austin. We do count the one at the corner of First and Austin as well making the total at 3 residences, but its address is First Street. Still we count it as the side of that residence faces into the interior of Walkable Main Street Village.



10. 11. **Double vacant lots corner Austin and Third** (owned by city) This is part of the parcel of land stretching from Austin on the north to State on the South that is proposed to be developed as a pocket neighborhood following the design examples of architect Ross Chapin.
